

Home and School Agreement

Parents

- I will keep the school informed about important information including emergency contact numbers.
- My child is in school everyday, on time.
- My child is only off when unwell or for necessary appointments.
- I will contact the school straight away when my child is not in school.
- I will not take holidays during term time.
- My child is picked up from school on time by an adult (over 16) who is known to the school.
- My child knows I support the school, its rules and behaviour policy.
- My child knows that I expect them to do their best with getting on with others in school.
- My child knows that I expect them to do their best with learning.
- I will support and encourage my child's educational development through the completion of homework and by providing other opportunities for learning at home.
- Come to important meetings about my child's learning.
- I will always raise any concerns with the school and not put negative comments about the school or other pupils/parents on any social media websites.
- My child wears the agreed uniform.
- I pay money to the school (dinner money etc.) promptly.
- I pay if my child has deliberately broken something.
- I will park and drive considerately outside school, never stopping on the zig-zag lines during restricted periods and, for the safety of all, never turning on them and respecting the local residents by not blocking their driveways.

Pupils

- I will attend school regularly and on time; wearing school uniform and bringing all the books and equipment I need every day.
- I will do all my class work and homework as well as I can.
- I will be helpful and considerate towards others and never bully another pupil.
- I will use the Internet safely and sensibly.
- I will respect other people and set a good example to children younger than myself.
- I will be sensible and well-behaved at work and at play.
- I will take care to avoid accidents and to avoid hurting other children.
- I will follow the school rules, be helpful and polite to adults and help to keep the school premises and resources neat and tidy.


